Questions about the child's birthplace were added to the birth history sequence beginning in 1997. The birthplace of a biological child was asked only if the child was born since January 1 of the prior wave, but the birthplace of an adopted child was asked regardless of birth year. This variable uses the FIPS state code to indicate the state in which the child was born. The county or specific foreign country was also coded but is considered a sensitive data item by the PSID. Access to sensitive data must be obtained by special request and a confidential data use contract.
